

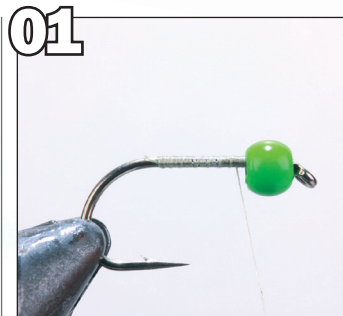


# Limey

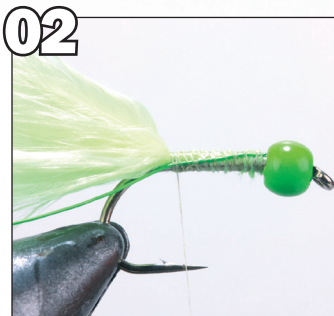
**Hook:** Short-shank, size 10 **Head:** 4mm green bead **Thread:** White Nano silk  
**Tail:** Lemon marabou **Body and tail:** Olive Holo tinsel **Rib:** Lime-green wire **Thorax:** Lime Glister



This is a colourful little number that finds favour with anglers when it comes to stalking rainbows and browns in clear water. The bright lime-green hue is easily tracked as it moves through the layers towards your target.



01 Place the bead on the hook and then the hook in the vice before running on the tying thread.



02 At the rear, tie in the marabou and the green rib. Keep the body nice and even.



03 Tie in the tinsel at either side of the tail and also tie in for the body.



04 Wind the tinsel up the hook shank in overlapping turns, securing behind the bead.



05 Now wind the rib up in nice open turns before securing behind the bead and trimming waste.



06 Form a dubbing rope and wind on a light collar behind the bead, varnish the thread before whip finishing and trimming.
